
CS205 - Lab 1

Objectives: In this lab you will learn how to

- design classes and the relationships between them
- document classes and their relationships with CRC and UML diagrams

Before starting this lab, you should have read Chapter 2 in your text. You will steps through a small design of a problem with CRC cards and UML.

- 1. Form small groups of no more than three students. Read through the problem description of exercise 2.18 on p87 of your text.
- 2. With a stack of index cards, describe classes for the problem, recording responsibilities and dependent classes on the cards.
- 3. Use your cards to walk through several user scenarios. Don't be afraid to tear up your designs and start fresh or go through several iterations before you find a design that works well.
- 4. Launch Violet and create a new class diagram and document your design in UML. Once you realize that you can right-click on nodes and edges, and then edit properties, it's pretty easy to achieve something like this:



5. Save your UML diagram and submit one copy for the group. Include everyone's name in a note in the diagram!
