cd linux-2.6.27.1
cp minimal.config ../build/.config

(you've just un-commented that line). Exit root, exit the shell, and start a new shell. You should be able to successfully run

sudo ls /root

without the shell complaining. If not, logout completely and login again. If that still doesn't work, you did something wrong. Go back and double-check everything.
